Ecumenical Enabler: Youth Engagement – Call for Applications

The PCC is the Regional Ecumenical Organisation of the Pacific, comprising 31 member Churches and 9 National Councils of Churches (NCCs).

The PCC is looking for a suitable and qualified young person (between 21 and 30yrs) to be the **Ecumenical Enabler** for its **Youth Engagement programme starting in August, 2020 for 3 years**. The role includes the coordination of the Pacific Ecumenical Youth Council, facilitation of the Young Ecumenists of the Pacific Fellowship and mobilisation of young Pacific Island Christians on issues affecting youth in the region.

The qualities, skills and academic requirements for the position are as follows:

- **Qualities and skills**
 - An active member of any PCC member churches and NCCs.
 - Keen interest in ecumenism and the work of the churches in the region.
 - Ability to work in a team and takes initiative with less supervision.
 - Good communication, analysis, research and writing skills.
 - Has organising and facilitation competencies.
 - A clear understanding of regional and global youth issues especially how these relate to the church.
 - Ability to engage with church leaders, youth groups within the church and the community as well as other organisations.
 - A working knowledge of the work of ecumenical organisations in the region.

- **Qualifications**
 - A minimum of a Diploma in a related field;
 - Demonstrated experience of working on Pacific youth issues; and
 - Experience in working with Christian organisations and/or churches

Person wishing to apply for this contract need to ensure the following:

- An application letter with a current Curriculum Vitae (CV);
- An endorsement letter signed by either the President/Moderator or General Secretary of her or his Church (Note! The Church or NCC must be a member of the PCC);
- Three referees, their names and contact details are noted in the application letter or CV;
- Three reference letters, one of which is to be the character reference, from each of the referees, and,
- Certified copies of academic certificates.
